AXELSON CENTER FOR NONPROFIT MANAGEMENT Online/Intensive Certificate in Nonprofit Management

The Axelson Center for Nonprofit Management at North Park University offers a unique and convenient approach for professionals to pursue graduate level coursework in nonprofit management through an online/intensive format. Scheduled to begin in March, 2004 in Portland, Oregon, the online certificate combines face-to-face instruction with the convenience of on-line learning. Students have an opportunity to get to know and network with each other at a Saturday intensive session that marks the beginning of each course, which helps strengthen group interaction and communication during the online phase of the course. This session is followed by seven weeks of online coursework facilitated by the instructor.

Irvington Village Retirement Community, 520 NE Mason St., in Portland, Oregon, is the site for the Saturday intensive sessions. As a property of Covenant Retirement Communities, Irvington Village features state-of-the-art classroom and learning technology accommodations.

Tuition for each course is \$850 and is two semester hours of graduate credit.
