Speaker

Klyne Snodgrass served North Park Theological Seminary as Professor of Biblical Literature from 1974 to 1989 and as Paul Brandel Professor of New Testament Studies from 1989 to 2015. He also served as Dean of the Faculty from 1988 to 1993, for a total of 41 years of dedicated service.



He has served as editor of *Ex Auditu*, an International Journal of Theological Interpretation of Scripture. He was also a consulting editor for the NIV Application Commentary of Zondervan Publishing House and a former co-chair of the Society of Biblical Literature Christian Theology and the Bible.
