 - Maintain constant communication with supervisors, teachers, & volunteers (via email, text, in person, etc.).
 - Host/facilitate trainings for teachers and volunteers.
- Teach/facilitate lessons when needed
- Develop and foster a dynamic youth community
- Be available to youth and their families
- Engage youth in community development activities
- Establish and maintain partnerships in the church and community
 - Connect with youth leaders in the city and other ministries of On Ramps including Journey children’s ministry
- Conduct weekly inventory of supplies, snacks, Bibles, etc.
