



## **Job Title: Youth Coordinator**

River Life Covenant Church seeks an engaged, committed individual to serve as Youth Coordinator for our Junior High and High School youth groups. The Youth Coordinator will serve as a role model by planning, organizing, and leading discipleship, worship, mission and activities for the youth.

### **Job Description:**

Lead, supervise, and implement the weekly gatherings of junior and high school youth (currently Sunday and Monday evenings during the school year). Walk alongside and disciple youth, helping them build relationships with Jesus and one another. Engage with youth families and adult volunteers in supporting youth ministry efforts. Coordinate with Leadership Team and church staff on short- and long-range planning. Meet with interim pastor and designated church leaders as part of mentoring and leadership development component.

### **Qualifications:**

- Personal relationship with Jesus Christ, devotion to God, love for His Word, and a commitment to prayer
- Previous experience with youth
- Leadership: driven, creative, and organized with strong time-management skills.
- Effective communicator: can connect with youth and coordinate well with parents/guardians, River Life Leadership Team, and church staff
- Teachable spirit, with evidence of incorporating feedback to modify one's practice or approach
- Able to teach using Bible-based curriculum
- Supportive of the vision, mission, and values of River Life Covenant Church

### **Responsibilities:**

- Serve as point person for youth ministry
- Plan and implement Sunday & Monday night youth group meetings
- Develop & lead special activities (small group Bible studies, scavenger hunts, lock-ins, etc.)
- Develop nurturing relationships with youth
- Engage with congregation to recruit and lead adult volunteers as part of a sustainable model for youth ministry
- Communicate on a regular basis with families of youth, and with congregation as appropriate
- Work with Leadership Team and church staff on effective outreach and communication strategies (including social media)
- Participate in the regular services at River Life

### **Education & Experience:**

- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college, or working towards this.

**Accountability:**

The Youth Leader is supervised by and accountable to the River Life Leadership Team. Performance evaluation at 90 days, 6 months, and 1 year.
