Interim Director of Christian Formation, with a focus on Children and Family Ministry

Position Overview:

The Interim Director of Christian Formation will help us bridge to a longer-term staffing vision for the discipleship ministries of the church and especially our call to encourage the spiritual nurture of children and families. We seek someone eager to love people into faith and toward maturity in Christ. They must have a demonstrated ability to connect with children, be able to effectively build and empower volunteer teams, and possess the organizational skills, initiative, and flexibility to navigate the unique challenges of an interim season with grace, patience, and sensitivity.

Key Responsibilities:

Adult Discipleship

- Encourage, equip, and resource Life Group leaders
- Facilitate broad participation in Life Groups and especially seek to connect those new to the church
- Support a variety of additional efforts to encourage Christian Formation among adults, including Sunday morning offering(s)
- With the lead pastor, assess current discipleship opportunities and explore areas for further growth and development as time and interest allow

Children and Family Ministry

- Coordinate for all aspects of Sunday morning children's ministry (nursery through elementary) in partnership with volunteer teachers, leaders, and the Children's Ministry Intern
- Lead weekly "56 Club" ministry for 5th and 6th graders, relying upon an existing team of trained college volunteers
- Encourage and shepherd families as they seek to guide their children in faith
- Periodically lead the "Story at the Steps" time during Sunday worship
- Actively participate in the emerging Children Youth and Family Ministry Team

- Growing and deepening faith in Jesus Christ
- At least two years of prior experience working with children and families, including curriculum and event planning, speaking, and supervising volunteers
- Possess a solid theology and philosophy of Christian Formation and Children and Family Ministry
- Excellence in written and oral communication skills (one-on-one, small groups, and large groups)
- Experience in managing people, teams, and processes; able to motivate and delegate
- Teachable and committed to personal accountability and growth
- Enthusiastic supporter of the ministry, mission, and vision of Montecito Covenant Church
